



Call for Presentation Submissions for the Advanced Learning in Palliative Medicine Conference

Hosted by the Canadian Society of Palliative Medicine

The Canadian Society of Palliative Medicine invites you to submit your presentation proposals for the 2026 Advanced Learning in Palliative Medicine Conference, which will be held **on May 28-30, 2026 in Winnipeg, Manitoba.**

The conference aims to provide a forum for sharing and discussing the latest research, best practices, and emerging issues in palliative medicine.

The presentations should be 15-20 minutes long, followed by a 5-minute question and answer period. The planning committee may invite some presenters to deliver a 60-minute presentation, depending on the topic and the availability of time slots.

Conference Objectives

- Apply acquired knowledge in advanced palliative medicine to treat patients living with a wide range of life-threatening illnesses
- Educate medical colleagues (practicing physicians and learners) about palliative care
- Recognize the importance of advocating for improved access to palliative care in local, regional, and national settings

Submission Guidelines

Presenters must give the presentation in person. There is no remuneration for presenting. The cost of registration is the responsibility of the presenter.

To submit your presentation proposal, **please fill out the online form by 11:30pm EST September 28, 2025.** You will be asked to provide the following information:

- Session title
- Brief summary of the presentation (max. 250 words)
- Three to five learning objectives (what the participants will learn or be able to do after attending your session)
- Detailed session description (max. 600 words)
- Session format
 - All sessions must be at least 25% interactive
 - Maximum number of 2 presenters per session



- Presenters cannot be added or changed after submission
- Topic importance to palliative care practice (max. 100 words)
- Your motivation for presenting at ALPM (max. 100 words)
- Key take home message(s) of your presentation (max. 50 words)
- The status of the material for the presentation (i.e., complete or in progress)
- Whether your topic is evidence based or experiential
- You will also be asked to complete a conflict of interest form

Scoring Criteria

- Relevance and significance to clinical practice in advanced level palliative medicine (20%)
- Originality (15%)
- Evidence-based (15%)
- Quality of methodology or project activity (15%)
- Practical tools for application in diverse settings (clinical, educational, quality etc.) (15%)
- Interactivity (10%)
- Submission is well written/clearly communicated (10%)

The planning committee will review all submissions and notify the applicants of the acceptance status by early November 2025.
